Every customer buying the TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS will receive a special Visit Japan Card.

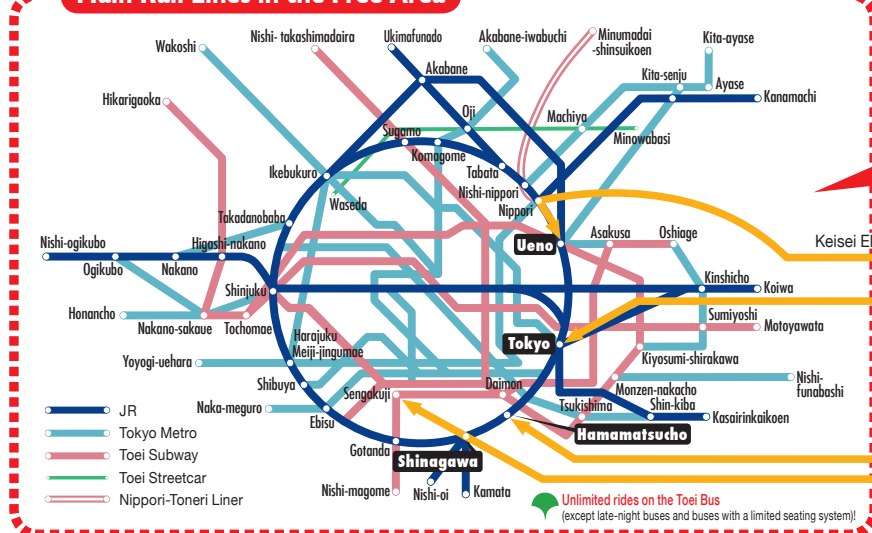

Visitors from abroad who hold rail tickets to the free area

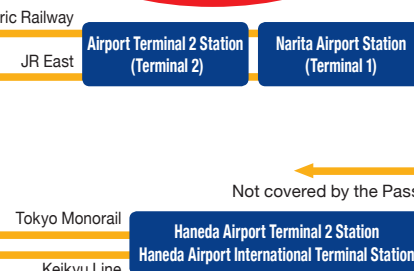
*Those who wish to use the Pass are asked to show their foreign passport when purchasing it.

Main Rail Lines in the Free Area

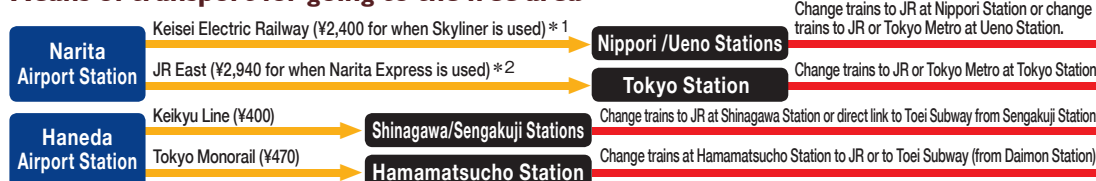


The **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** allows unlimited rides on JR trains, Tokyo Metro and Toei Subway, Nippori-Toneri Liner, Toei Streetcar, and Toei Bus within the free area.

*In the case of JR East trains, the use is limited to ordinary car non-reserved seats of local trains (including express trains).



Means of transport for going to the free area



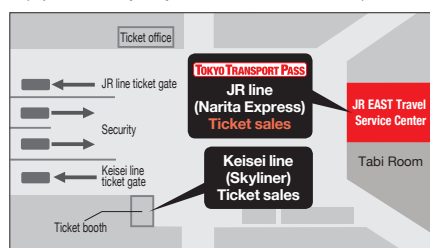
The **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** allows unlimited rides within the free area.

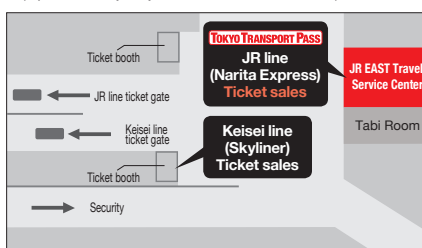
Where to Purchase

The **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** can be purchased at JR EAST Travel Service Centers as shown in the following diagram. * The Pass can only be purchased at the JR stations shown below.

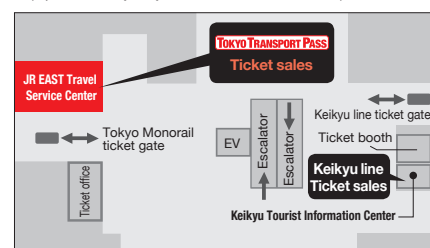
● Narita International Airport Terminal 1 (B1F)

How to Use

When boarding and disembarking at stations in the free area, please go through the automatic ticket gate as shown in the following photo.

Insert your **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** in the insertion slot and pass through the wicket. Then, take the Pass from the retrieval slot.

*Be careful not to forget to take the Pass from the machine.



○ When you disembark at a station outside the free area, please pay the extra fare required for the section you have traveled outside the free area to the station staff at the manned gate.

○ When you board at a station outside the free area, please purchase a ticket to go to the station located at the boundary of the free area.

*When you use the Toei Bus or Toei Streetcar, please show your **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** to the driver (conductor) when you board the bus or train.

Refunds

Only when the Pass is unused and valid, a refund can be offered after deducting 210 yen for the refund handling fee. For details, please ask the ticket booth where it was purchased.

Credit cards that will be accepted

Payment for the **TOKYO TRANSPORT PASS** can be made by cash (yen) or using one of the following cards.



Other information

- The starting date of the Pass may not be changed.
- Refunds cannot be made for canceled or delayed train service.
